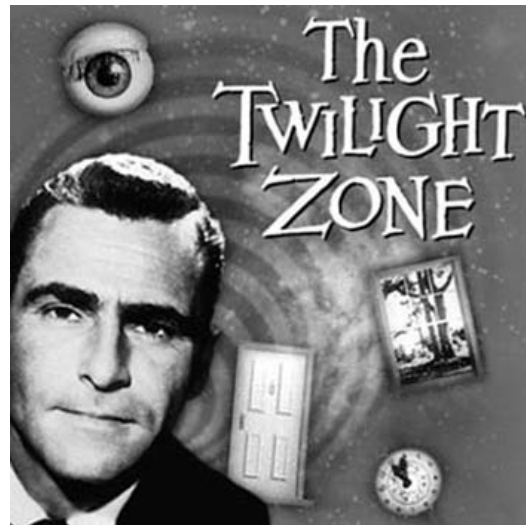


TWZ at OWG
